

Man faces 11 counts of breaching terms

COURTS • A Calgary man convicted last week of hit and run causing the death of 20-year-old Lindsay Giacomelli in a vehicle-pedestrian collision on March 17, 2005, now faces 11 counts of breaching his release conditions over the past two years.

Colin Jones, 49, was represented by lawyer Lisa Burgis for the brief appearance in provincial court on Thursday. It was adjourned until May 17.

He faces one charge from 2005 and 10 more from last year, mostly for not being home by the start of his court-ordered curfew.

Sentencing arguments for Jones on the hit-and-run charge, which occurred in the Bonaventure Drive crosswalk on St. Patrick's Day two years ago, are scheduled for May 15.
