

Hit-and-run accused pleads not guilty

COURT

- The Calgary man charged in the fatal hit and run of a University of Calgary student has pleaded not guilty to 10 counts of violating court orders.

Colin Jones, 48, was charged with hit and run for allegedly striking Lindsay Giacomelli, 20, with his vehicle in a Bonaventure Drive S.E. crosswalk on March 17, 2005.

Giacomelli succumbed to her injuries at Foothills hospital the next day.

Jones was involved in another collision with a flat-bed truck in Carstairs and was arrested the following day in Toronto, after purchasing a one-way ticket to fly to Gatwick, England.

His lawyer entered a plea of not guilty on 10 counts of breaching recognizance.
