The Lindsay Rachel Giacomelli Memorial Fund was established in Lindsay's name as a memorial to her short life (June 18, 1984 to March 18, 2005). The goal of the fund is to keep Lindsay's name and presence alive and to reflect her generous and caring spirit (www.lindsaygiacomelli.com).

The Lindsay Rachel Giacomelli Memorial Fund is an endowment fund administered by The Calgary Foundation; all contributions to the fund remain at the Foundation forever. Each year 4.5% of the fund's value is used for a charitable donation to a local cause. Previous donations have been made to the Calgary Zoo, the Calgary Military Museum Society, the Alberta Children's Hospital Foundation (the Rotary / Flames House), the Calgary Health Trust (Foothills Hospital ICU), Alberta Ballet, The Alberta Children's Hospital Foundation, the Princess Patricia's Canadian Light Infantry Regiment (PPCLI) Museum and Archives Gallery Renovation and The Mustard Seed. Donations to date total \$65,205 directly from Lindsay's Fund, and \$28,500 from our Platinum Sponsors.

This years donations total will be \$16,747 from Lindsay's Fund and \$10,500 from our Platinum Sponsors for a total donation of \$27,247! The estimated value of Lindsay's Fund will then be at \$391,000. The Fund will provide charitable donations to Calgary area causes forever, all in Lindsay's name.

This year's primary donation will be made to the Alberta Adolescent Recovery Centre (AARC). The Alberta Adolescent Recovery Centre is an accredited not for profit long-term intensive treatment centre for chemically addicted adolescents between the ages of 13 and 21. Since its inception in 1991, AARC has graduated over 500 clients and approximately 1800 additional family members. Although based in Calgary, the organization is unique to Alberta and Canada in terms of its program model and success rate in treating teens with severe drug and alcohol addiction. The Centre provides a family oriented, long-term treatment model for young people who have reached a point of serious addiction to drugs and alcohol; they are often a last resort, offering a safe and loving environment for teens recovering from addiction.
