The Lindsay Rachel Giacomelli Memorial Fund was established in Lindsay's name as a memorial to her short life (June 18, 1984 to March 18, 2005). The goal of the fund is to keep Lindsay's name and presence alive and to reflect her generous and caring spirit (<a href="www.lindsaygiacomelli.com">www.lindsaygiacomelli.com</a>).

The Lindsay Rachel Giacomelli Memorial Fund is an endowment fund administered by The Calgary Foundation. All contributions to the fund remain at the Foundation forever. Each year 4.0% of the fund's value is used for a charitable donation to a local cause. Previous donations have been made to the Calgary Zoo, the Calgary Military Museum Society and PPCLI Museum, the Alberta Children's Hospital Foundation (the Rotary / Flames House), the Calgary Health Trust (Foothills Hospital ICU), Alberta Ballet, The Mustard Seed, The Captain Nichola Goddard Light Up Papua Guinea Project, the Heart Beats Children's Society of Calgary and the Alberta Adolescent Recovery Centre. The total charitable donations to date total \$80,089 directly from Lindsay's Fund and \$39,000 from our Platinum sponsors.

Thanks to your generous support last year we raised over \$48,000 at the event. This allowed us to make \$25,384 in charitable donations in 2014 consisting of \$10,500 from our Platinum Sponsors, and \$14,884 from Lindsay's Fund. \$37,898 was deposited into Lindsay's Fund which as of November 16, 2014 was valued at \$408,386.

The fund will provide charitable donations to Calgary area causes forever, all in Lindsay's name. This year's primary donation will be made to the Kids Help Phone. 








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
