



Thank you for your Support

We would like to take this opportunity to thank each and every one of the people who attended, sponsored, donated, or assisted in any way with the 6th Annual Lindsay Rachel Giacomelli Memorial Golf Tournament. We had an outstanding day. We can't thank you enough for your support and for your recognition of Lindsay.

Thanks to your participation we were sold out again, with a full slate of 128 golfers, and an additional 24 people attending the dinner and silent auction. As a result of the successful turnout we raised approximately \$26,500 at the event. Of this total, \$3,000 will be donated directly to the Alberta Ballet by our Platinum Sponsor Warwick Industries Ltd. and approximately \$23,500 will go directly into Lindsay's Fund. The estimated value of Lindsay's Fund (based on the March 31, 2010 statement) will be \$218,200 as of June 14, 2010. That's a growth of approximately \$62,000 in the fund value over the past 12 months, which is a combination of this fund raising event, individual donations to the fund, and fund performance as an investment vehicle.

The Lindsay Rachel Giacomelli Memorial Fund, through the Calgary Foundation, is set up like an endowment; all donations to the fund remain there forever. Each year 5% of the fund's value is designated for a charitable donation. This amount is essentially what the fund earns over the year as an investment.

The total donation this year from the fund will be approximately \$12,700, including the direct donation from Warwick Industries. This amount will be donated to our primary recipient, the Alberta Ballet. A portion will also be donated to The Light Up Papua New Guinea Project in memory of Captain Nichola Goddard <http://www.nicholagoddard.com/>. The total donation this year is based on the value of the fund during the past year. The 2011 donation will be based on the fund value during this coming year, and can be estimated to be approximately \$11,000.

The establishment of this fund provides our family extreme comfort in the knowledge that the fund will provide charitable donations to Calgary area causes forever, all in Lindsay's name.

This event will happen again on Friday June 10, 2011 to coincide with Lindsay's birthday of June 18. I hope you will join us again next year to celebrate and remember Lindsay at the 7th Annual Lindsay Giacomelli Memorial Golf Tournament.
