



## Thank you for your Support

We would like to take this opportunity to thank each and every one of the people who attended, sponsored, donated, or assisted in any way with the 11<sup>th</sup> Annual Lindsay Rachel Giacomelli Memorial Golf Tournament. We had an outstanding day (though it was cold enough that the Scotch Marshall should have been driving around). We can't thank you enough for your support and for your recognition of Lindsay.

Thanks to your participation we were sold out again, with a full slate of 144 golfers. Response this year was outstanding with the event sold out in January for the 3<sup>rd</sup> year in a row. We had 23 tournament sponsors, including our Tournament Sponsor, 4 corporate Platinum Sponsors and 1 Platinum level private donation.

As a result of the successful turnout we raised approximately \$51,308 at the event. Of this total, \$8,000 will be donated directly to the Kids Help Phone courtesy of our Platinum Sponsors Warwick Structures Group, Lauren Engineers & Constructors, RN Engineering, and Atlas Oil & Gas Process Systems, and our private Platinum Donor.

The remaining approximately \$43,308 will go directly into Lindsay's Fund. (I take credit for donations made directly to the Fund through the Calgary Foundation, following my notice for the golf tournament in January. I figure that reminds people and they donate!). The estimated value of Lindsay's Fund will be \$486,584 as of June 18, 2015.

The Lindsay Rachel Giacomelli Memorial Fund, through the Calgary Foundation, is an endowment; all donations to the fund remain there forever. Each year 4% of the fund's value is designated for a charitable donation. This amount is essentially what the fund earns over the year as an investment.

The total donation this year from Lindsay's Fund will be \$17,731. Of this total \$500 will go to The Light Up Papua New Guinea Project in memory of Captain Nichola Goddard <a href="https://www.nicholagoddard.com/lupng.php">www.nicholagoddard.com/lupng.php</a>, This will help put solar powered LED lighting systems into medical clinics in isolated villages in Papua New Guinea. The balance being \$17,231, along with the Platinum Sponsor amount of \$8,000 (\$25,231 total) will be donated to the Kids Help Phone <a href="https://www.kidshelpphone.ca">www.kidshelpphone.ca</a>.

By being "open for business" 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year, the Kids help Phone promises to always be there for kids; for the small things and the big challenges facing young people today.

Please note that Kids Help Phone does not receive any core government funding (federal or provincial) nor are they a United Way recipient. All funds come from the generous support of donors and events such as the Lindsay Rachel Giacomelli Memorial Fund.

With this year's donations, Lindsay's Fund will have donated approximately \$97,320 and the Platinum Sponsor donations will have contributed a donation amount of \$47,000 for a total donation of \$144,320. Wow! The primary donations through the years have been to:

- Kids Help Phone (2015)

The 2016 donation will be based on the fund value on March 31, 2016, and is estimated to be \$19,463.

The establishment of this fund provides our family extreme comfort in the knowledge that the fund will provide charitable donations to Calgary and Alberta area causes forever, all in Lindsay's name.

This was the final golf tournament for the fund. It's time to try something new before we get old and stale. Maybe we'll resurrect it on the 15<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary/maybe not. We had what may be "the inaugural barn dance" on Saturday following the tourney this year, with invitations to long time tourney participants and sponsors, with 110 people attending. That may turn into an annual event.

I hope you picked up a tournament mug, and have a look at that logo when you drink a coffee relaxing on a Saturday or Sunday morning.

A special thanks to my long time sponsors and participants who've been there every year since we started. The 1<sup>st</sup> tournament was in 2005, 3 months after Lindsay passed away. It was arranged by my buddy Dave with 57 golfers and raised \$11,000 for the Fund. No planning, it just happened.

The 2006 tournament was organized but didn't have any sponsors, and started fund raising with silent auction and raffles at the tournament.

The tournament became more organized every year and in 2007 we started to solicit sponsors. We had 10 that year. We peaked in 2014 with 26 sponsors.
