Cops allege bail breach By STAFF

Out on bail while waiting to stand trial on charges stemming from a fatal hit-and-run accident, a Calgary man was arrested for breaching the terms of his release.

Colin Jones was picked up for the alleged infractions Saturday.

The 48-year-old is accused in the death of Lindsay Giacomelli, 20, who was struck in a crosswalk at Bonaventure Dr. S.E. on St. Patrick's Day last year.

Traffic Sgt. Doug McIlwraith said these latest charges follow a continuing investigation.

Jones is back out on bail and is scheduled to appear in provincial court Feb. 23.
