LANGLEY - A bill named after a teen who lost her life on a rural Langley road is finally heading to the House of Commons for a vote.

Carley's Law, a bill that would toughen the penalty for convicted hit-and-run drivers, is expected to be up for debate among MPs on Feb. 23, said former Langley-Abbotsford MP Randy White, who now sits for Abbotsford only.

The veteran MP expects the vote on the private members bill will be taken in the first week of March.
